NESG Non-Residential Fellowship Programme (NRFP) – Objectives

The broad objective of the NRFP is to bridge the gap between socio-economic research and public policy, and promote evidence-based policy making in Nigeria.

Other objectives include:

- To encourage interactions among academia, governments, private sector and non-governmental organization.
- To promote evidence-based policy making by transmitting valuable research outputs and interventions into the policy making process.

The Programme will bring together outstanding high-level intellectuals in the academia, research-based institutions and the private sector to support the research and advocacy work of the NESG. The Programme will encourage collaboration and ideas sharing among experts and ensure that findings from its research are applied in practice.

Scope of Fellowship Activities

i. RESEARCH

- Under the guidance of the NESG Management, Fellows will select **research projects** relevant to the development of the Nigerian economy. These research projects will reflect the sub-themes or emerging issues within the scope of the cluster group.

ii. DIALOGUE SESSIONS

- Some Fellows will be seconded to work with **Policy Commissions, Public Policy Management Unit and Policy Innovation Unit** based on their experience and expertise.
- In this position, they will work as "**Technical Expert**" to selected Policy Commission.
- Also, each research cluster is expected to organise "**Quarterly Policy Dialogue**" to discuss and share findings with stakeholders.

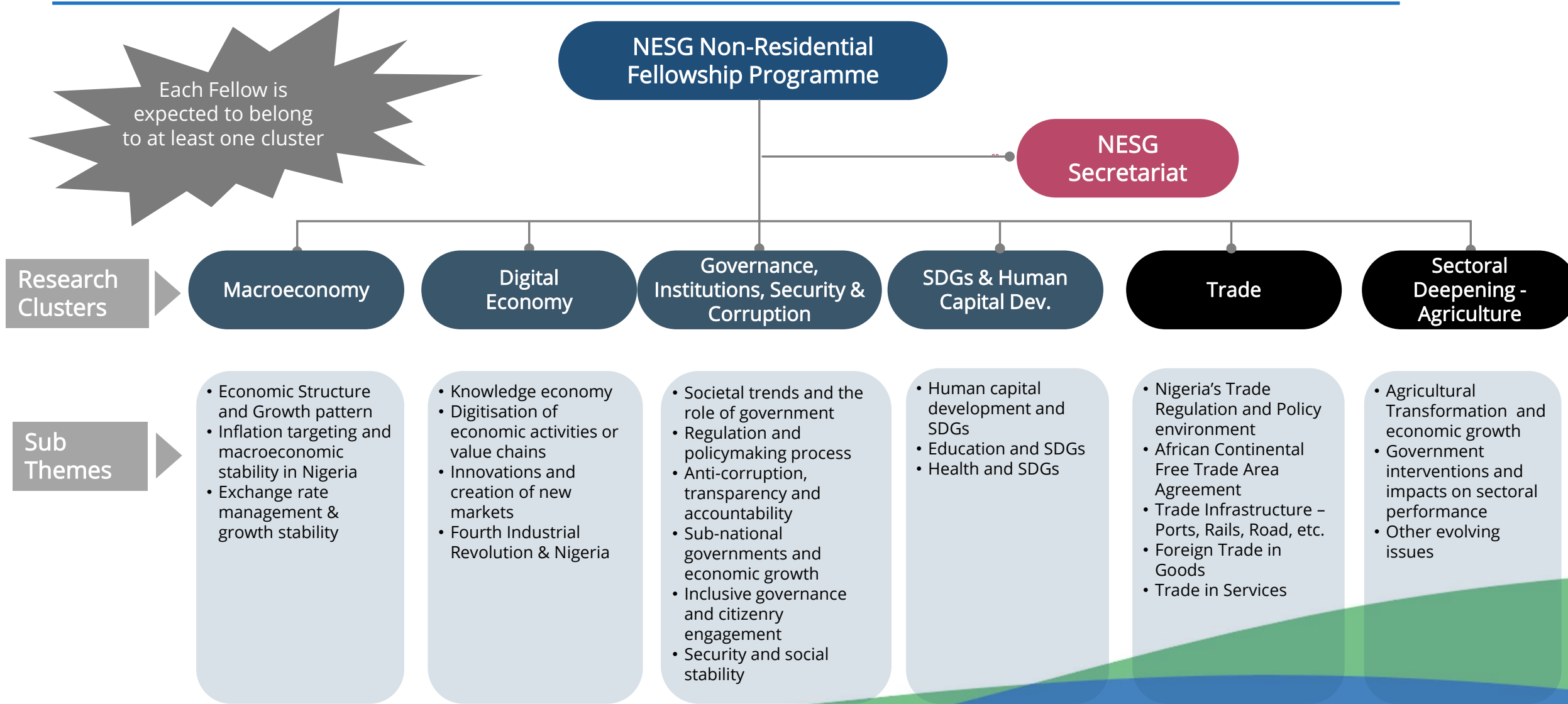
iii. ADVOCACY

- In collaboration with NESG's **Information & Communication and Research Departments**, Fellows will engage advocacy activities which include interviews with media outfits, including radio stations, television stations, and print media.

iv. MEETING

- An important part of the Fellowship programme is the "Fellows' Meeting", which is expected to occur on a "quarterly basis".

NESG Non-Residential Fellowship Programme (NRFP) – Structure

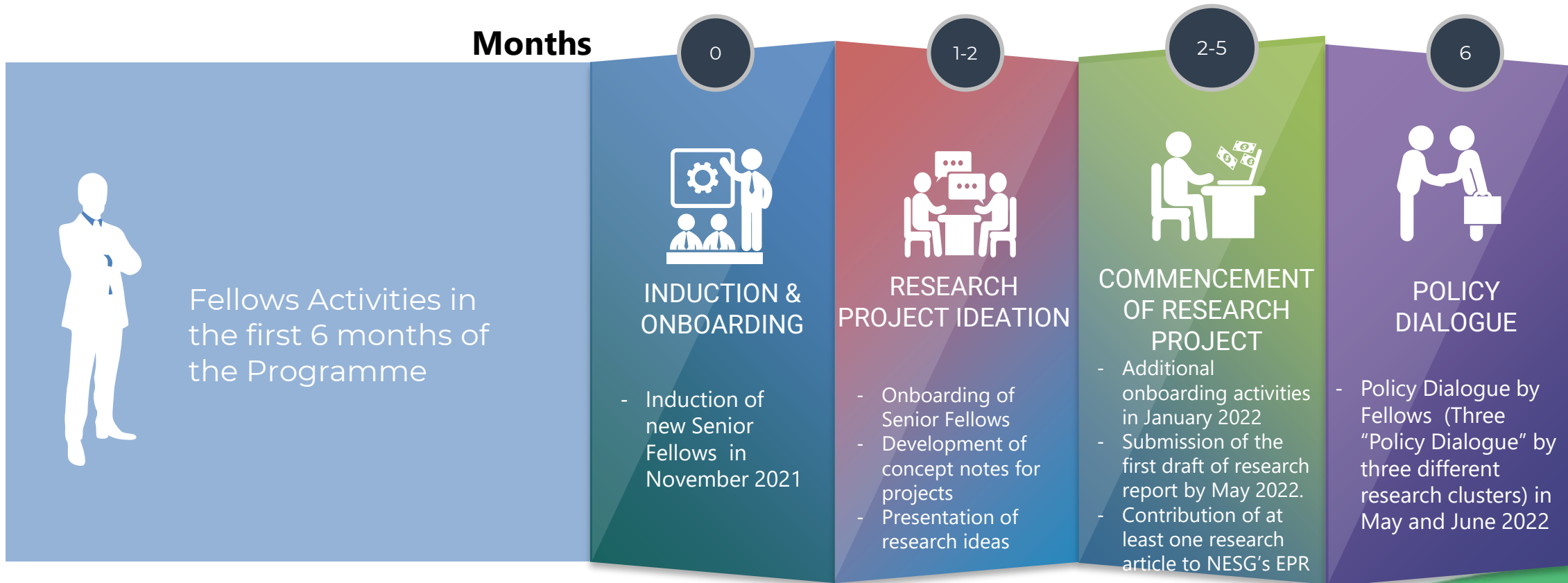

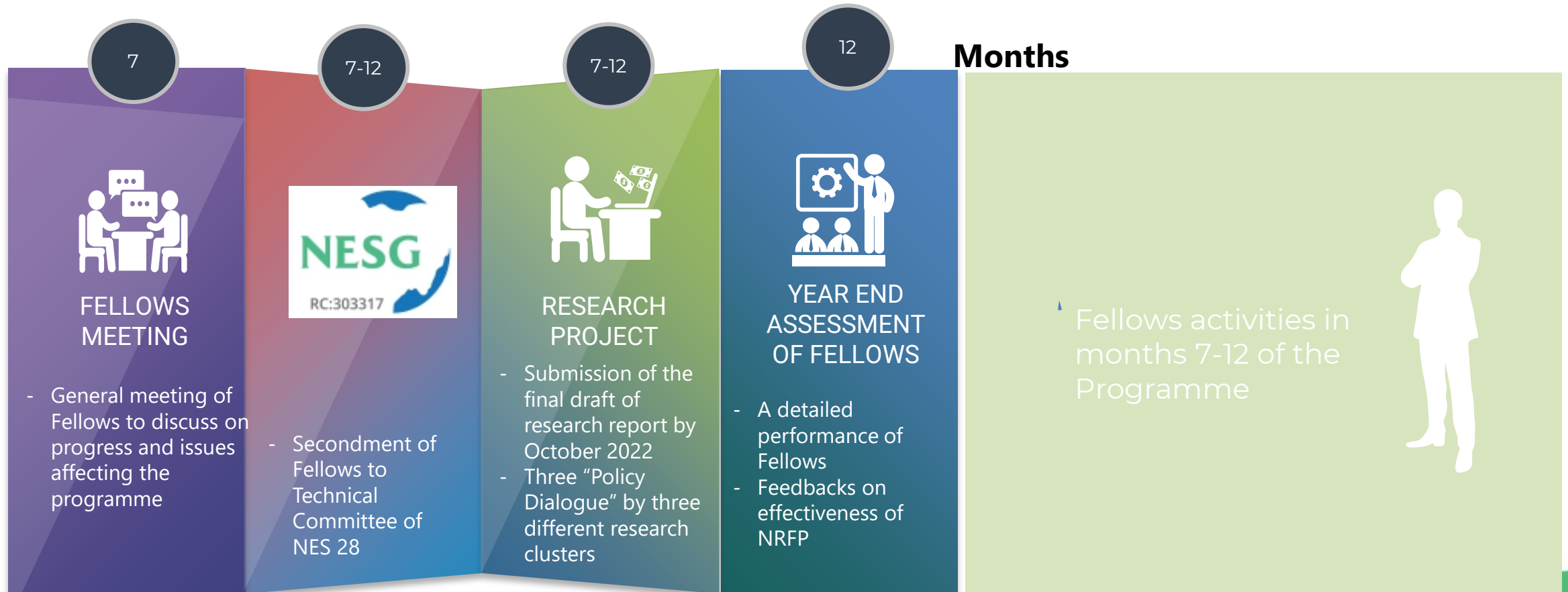
